CRL (Crossrail Limited) is the nominated undertaker appointed and funded by the Sponsors to manage and implement the Crossrail Project as defined in the Project Development Agreement (PDA) in accordance with an agreed Delivery Strategy. Its governance must be clear where responsibility and accountability rests, and how decisions are made in a controlled way.

Crossrail Programme Governance - Crossrail Learning Legacy

Crossrail Ltd (CRL) is responsible for development and delivery of the new infrastructure, in accordance with the requirements of the Sponsors, up to the point at which it is accepted by the long-term operators of the infrastructure. The scope of Crossrail is derived from the requirements defined in the following documents:

For the delivery phase of Crossrail, the sponsors (TfL/DfT) established a governing body in the form of a Joint Sponsor Board (JSB, now referred to as Crossrail Sponsor Board), comprising two members from each of the two principal funding bodies.
