Development of the Dyadic Relationship Scale

The FAM-III consists of three forms: the General Scale examines overall family health; the Dyadic Relationship Scale examines how a family member views his or her relationship with another family member; and the Self-Rating Scale allows each person to rate his or her own functioning within the family.

Measuring Dyadic Adjustment: New Scales

Dyadic measures provide a perspective into family relationships that is not possible with self-report measures that are limited to personal behavior or with global assessments of family functioning (Cook & Kenny, 2006).

Dyadic Measures of the Parent-Child Relationship During ...

The Dyadic Adjustment Scale is a 32-item measure of dyadic adjustment, or the relationship quality of cohabiting couples, married or unmarried. Different aspects of dyadic adjustment captured by the scale are represented in 4 subscales: dyadic consensus, dyadic satisfaction, dyadic cohesion, and affectional expression.

Family measures include assessment tools spanning observational and self-report methods and fall into three broad assessment categories: family functioning, dyadic family relationships, and family functioning in the context of childhood chronic health conditions.
