The ESC recently published guidelines for the general management of acute coronary syndromes (ACS) in patients presenting without persistent ST-segment elevation. 60 The present guidelines focus on PCI to optimize the management of patients presenting with NSTEMI-ACS. Patients demonstrating elevated serum markers (troponin (Tn)-I, Tn-T, or CK-MB) will be subsequently considered to have non-ST-segment elevation myocardial infarction (NSTEMI).

1Operators who perform <75 procedures/year should develop a defined mentoring relationship with a highly experienced operator who has an annual procedural volume >150 procedures/year. 2Performance standard: balloon inflation within 90 (±30) min of hospital admission. 3Individuals who perform ≥75 PCI procedures/year.

① Guidelines give clear indications when intervention is appropriate and emphasize the role of the Heart Team in making recommendations ② Guidelines state that 'ad hoc' PCI should not be a default procedure ③ Guidelines recommend that institutional protocols can be used to avoid systematic need to review every case

In a contemporary analysis from the NCDR, the incidence of PCI-related stroke was 0.22%. 247 In-hospital mortality in patients with PCI-related stroke is 25% to 30%. 247,248 Factors associated with an increased risk of stroke include fibrinolytic therapy administered before PCI (OR: 4.7), known cerebrovascular disease (OR: 2.20), STEMI as the ...
