The Document.write () method writes a string of text to a document stream opened by document.open (). Note: as document.write writes to the document stream, calling document.write on a closed (loaded) document automatically calls document.open, which will clear the document.

The input file is just a plain text file, with the extension.tex. It will contain code that the computer interprets to produce a PDF file.
