The market cross at Milton, Ross-shire, is a typical example; likewise the one illustrated from Clackmannan above. The market cross at Findhorn, Elginshire, shows an exception to our general type, in that the stepped base is circular instead of square. Other variants include hexagonal or octagonal stepped bases, and square or round-section shafts.
